

THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL
ORDER UNDER SECTION 16A OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
FOR THE PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTION ON HIGHWAYS
HALTEMPRICE 10K RUN
VARIOUS ROADS IN THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE

On 21st October 2022 The East Riding of Yorkshire Council made a regulation under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will be operative on Sunday 30th October 2022. The effect of the regulation will be:-

1. To prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed along the following roads :-

<u>Lengths of road to be closed</u>	<u>Period of Closure</u>
Broadley Avenue, Anlaby – the full extent Woodland Drive, Anlaby – the full extent Mill Lane, Kirk Ella - between the junctions of Woodland Drive and Easenby Avenue Easenby Avenue, Kirk Ella - between the junctions of Mill Lane and Grundale Valley Drive, Kirk Ella – the full extent West Ella Road, Kirk Ella - between the junctions of Valley Drive and Beech Hill Road Occupational Lane, Swanland - between the junction of West Ella Road for a distance of approximately 200 metres heading towards the junction of Swanland Dale (for the purpose of a safety area) Beech Hill Road, Swanland - between the junctions of West Ella Road and Main Street Main Street, Swanland - between the junction of Beech Hill Road to the continuation of West End, Swanland Kemp Road, Swanland - between the junctions of West End and Tranby Lane Tranby Lane, Swanland - between the junctions of Kemp Road and Greenstiles Lane Greenstiles Lane, Swanland – the full extent	Between 08:30 hours and 10:30 hours on Sunday 30 th October 2022 These closures will operate as rolling road closures and the roads will be reopened once the runners have passed consistent with maintaining public safety

2. The Order will not extend to emergency vehicles.
3. The Order shall not prevent at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the said lengths of road.
4. The Regulation may be examined during normal office hours from the date of this Notice until 30th October 2022, at Haltemprice Customer Services and Library, East Riding Leisure Haltemprice, 120 Springfield Way, Anlaby HU10 6QJ and Beverley Customer Service Centre, Cross Street, Beverley HU17 9BA.
