<u>THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL</u> ORDER UNDER SECTION 16A OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 FOR THE PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTION ON HIGHWAYS <u>HALTEMPRICE 10K RUN</u> <u>VARIOUS ROADS IN THE EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE</u>

On 21st October 2022 The East Riding of Yorkshire Council made a regulation under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which will be operative on Sunday 30th October 2022. The effect of the regulation will be:-

1. To prohibit any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to proceed along the following roads :-

- 2. The Order will not extend to emergency vehicles.
- 3. The Order shall not prevent at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the said lengths of road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from, the said lengths of road.
- 4. The Regulation may be examined during normal office hours from the date of this Notice until 30th October 2022, at Haltemprice Customer Services and Library, East Riding Leisure Haltemprice, 120 Springfield Way, Anlaby HU10 6QJ and Beverley Customer Service Centre, Cross Street, Beverley HU17 9BA.
